All members receive the Association magazine – the **ONLOOKER** by post 3 times a year. The aim is to produce at least 24 pages (4 in colour) with regular articles and plenty of news and pictures. We hold an Annual Church Service and General Meeting normally at Wesley's Chapel London. The LSA has 3 social sections, Bugle and Brass Bands plus Bowls. They meet, practice and take part in a number of events, throughout the year. Members with musical and bowls skills are warmly invited to join these sections.

The Annual Membership subscription is £10 payable on the 1st January each year covering 1st January – 31st December. You can, however, join at anytime of the year. Joining between April & July, it is reduced to £6.75 and between August & November to £3.50. Alternatively, **Life Membership for a one off payment of £100** is available.

Your subscriptions and donations cover the cost of printing and posting the 3 ONLOOKER magazines plus our Association administration costs. What is left over has enabled us to donate in excess of **£54,000** over the **past 27 years**, to the BB in London, Nationally and worldwide. There have also been other occasions when we have responded to appeals from major charities.
